WHO WE ARE

Church of the Good Shepherd, Monkstown is a Church of Ireland/Methodist local covenant partnership church in the heart of Monkstown estate, Newtownabbey. We are a family of believers who have a heart to see Monkstown transformed by the good news of Jesus.

Our main Sunday service is at 11 am and currently we have an average of 80-100 people attending each Sunday, with around 20-25 of those under 18. Currently, we are seeing our numbers of children and teenagers grow both on a Sunday morning and in our youth fellowship. Our worship on a Sunday is informal and contemporary. We begin worship together as a family and then after a kids' talk and song, our children and teenagers go to either Creche & Smile (0-11) or Bible Class (12-18). Our youth group Sprockets has around 18-20 teenagers who meet twice a month, and we currently have a group of 14 heading to Summer Madness. We also have a youth band that leads worship on a Sunday around once a month and a number of young people who serve in the worship team each week. We have a strong and committed team of leaders currently in place who have been instrumental in the growth we've been experiencing.

Nathan Ervine has been our minister since December 2023 and has a heart to see people coming to know Jesus and seeing them released in their gifts as they serve him.

JOB PURPOSE

MAIN RESPONSIBILITIES

- Develop and implement an evangelistic vision to reach families in the Monkstown area
- Develop creative ways of reaching children, young people and families during the week
- Work alongside volunteers to disciple young people connected to the church
- Build good relationships with young people and parents
- Attend our weekly Parents and Toddlers group (Wednesday mornings)
- Build good relationships with our uniformed organisations and help where needed
- Build good relationships with the local schools
- Help lead and co-ordinate Creche, Smile and Bible Class on a Sunday morning
- Participate in leading Sunday worship including teaching at all-age services, and being involved in Sunday worship
- Encourage and recruit volunteers
- Attend Youth Activities (Sprockets, Connect Youth Service, Youth Home Group)
- Help co-ordinate and lead groups of young people going on residential events eg; Connor takes the Castle, Autumn Soul, Soul Mates, and Summer Madness
- Co-ordinate church social media to communicate and inform young people and their families of events and initiatives
- Commit to praying for the children, young people, and families of the church and those we come into contact with
